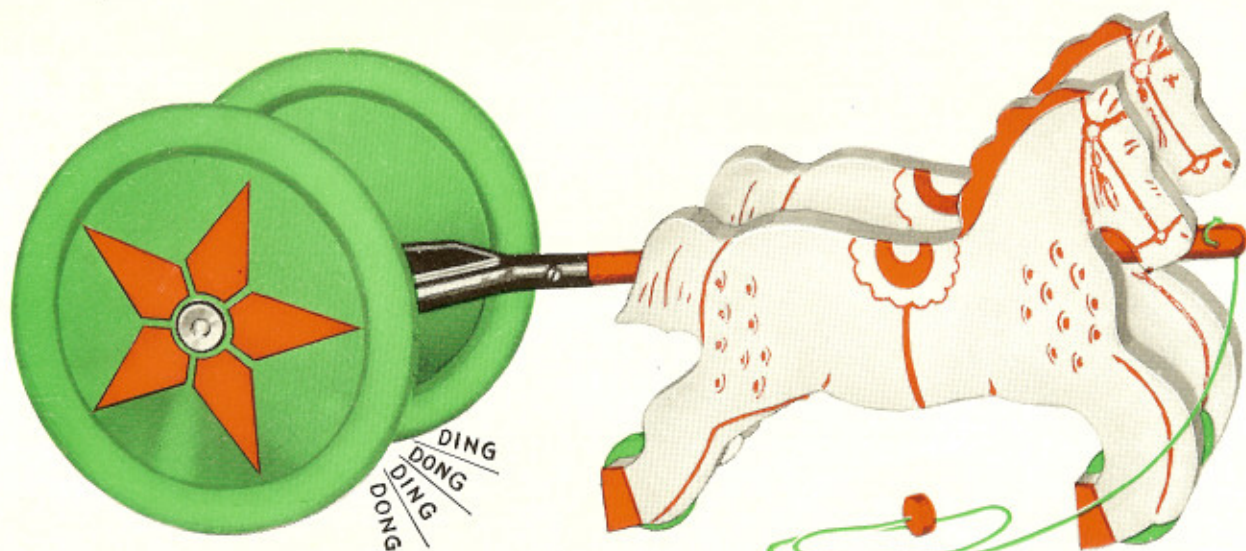

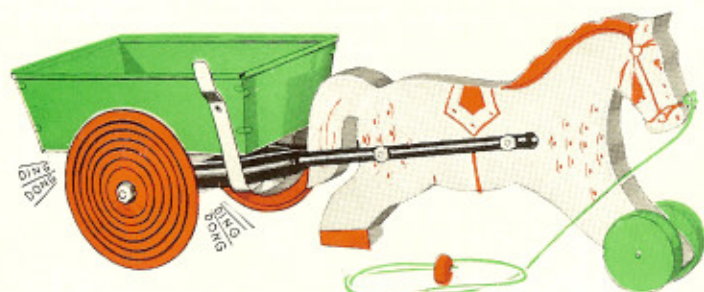

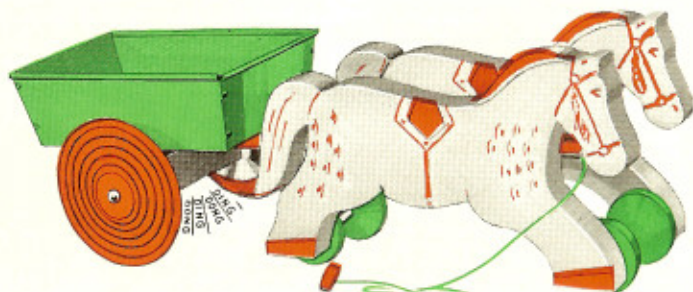
No. 246 TANDEM CHIME

A pair of circus horses pull a beautifully decorated floor chime. Extra play value in attaching and detaching the horses.



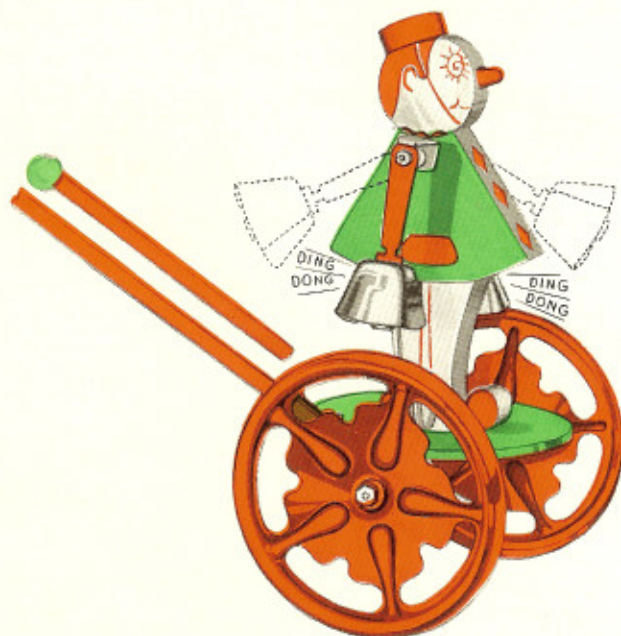
No. 247 PONY CART
